



EMERGENCY MEDICAL TECHNICIAN COURSE

Dear Prospective EMT Student –

Thank you for your interest in the Rocky Mountain Resuscitation, LLC® Emergency Medical Technician (EMT) Course. The intention of the EMT certification program is to train an individual to function independently in a medical emergency. The course provides the basic knowledge and skills needed to deliver Basic Life Support (BLS) care and is required to progress to more advanced levels of prehospital patient care. This is a fun class, but it does require time and commitment both in and out of class.

The course requires a minimum of 150 hours of classroom and skills instruction and Clinical/Field rotations. For these rotations, you will need to ride an **ambulance** to obtain no less than ten (10) patient contacts. This course is setup to train individuals to serve as a vital link in the chain of the health care team. This includes all skills necessary to provide emergency medical care as an attendant-in-charge (AIC) on a BLS ambulance. This course requires students to bring a laptop/iPad/tablet to class and to be knowledgeable on using as students will be using electronic devices to access the book electronically, Learning Management System (LMS) and cognitive testing.

Eligibility to attend an Emergency Medical Technician course in Virginia requires that you must:

- (1) Be proficient in reading, writing, and speaking the English language.
- (2) Be a minimum of 16 years of age at the ending date of the certification course. If less than 18 years of age, you must provide the course coordinator with a completed parental permission form with the signature of a parent or guardian verifying approval for enrollment in the course.
- (3) Have no physical or mental impairment that would render them unable to perform all cognitive and psychomotor skills required for that level of certification.
- (4) Hold current certification in an Office of Emergency Medical Services approved Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) course at the beginning date of the course. This certification must also be current at the time of state testing. You will be required to send in a copy of your CPR card with your application to ensure that it meets our requirements. If it does not or you do not have a card, you can take the class we provide.

The majority of the classes will be held at Rocky Mountain Resuscitation, LLC, located at 420 Hudgins Rd, Suite 217, Fredericksburg, VA 22408.

Classes take place on Tuesday, Thursdays and every other Saturdays (the schedule is below).
Topic schedule may change, but the dates and times will remain.

We will offer a CPR Course on Saturday **Jun 27** starting at 0900 until complete. If you are unable to attend our dates, you can take a course from another source but must bring a valid card the first day of class **Jul 9, 26**. If you need help finding an alternate CPR class, please let me know. If we have many conflicts, we will consider offering a second option. Just communicate if you need a class as soon as possible.

The total cost of the course is \$1,500 and is due in full by Thursday, July 9, 2026. Tuition includes the electronic textbook, CPR certification (if needed), initial testing fee, blood pressure cuff, and stethoscope. Payment may be made by credit card, cash, Venmo, or check payable to Rocky Mountain Resuscitation.


Students must have access to a laptop, iPad, or tablet to complete required coursework, including accessing the textbook, submitting homework, and taking quizzes. Success in this course also requires a commitment to study and practice outside of scheduled class hours.

You are required to attend an informal interview. The informal interview (more of a meet and greet) will be Saturday Jun 27, the same day as CPR class. If you also need CPR your interview will be conducted after class. If this date does not work for you, we can schedule another day/time. Just communicate if you need another date for the interview as soon as possible. The attached schedule is the tentative days/subjects.

E-mail your applications to the course coordinator at lance@rockymountainresus.com. Anyone registering for this class must submit an application. If you do not have the capability to e-mail the application, please take a picture and text it to the below number. If you should have any questions, please feel free to contact the course coordinator listed below via email or text. If you need to talk or meet, please text the request and we will get something scheduled. By or before 1800 on Jun 27 you will be notified if you are accepted into EMT class.
